

NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 24

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 24 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, November 6, 2025, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2400, in the Navasota Conference Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:
